

8 Factors to Consider Before Making a Decision

There's a lot to think about when bringing new technology into your organization, but it doesn't have to be complicated or intimidating. Keep the decision simple with this checklist of the most important considerations for your purchase.

Simplicity

As simple to use as a traditional whiteboard

Users should be able to simply grab a pen and start sketching on the board. Your whiteboard should serve as the organizational locus for a brainstorming session or the place where the abstract threads and visions swirling in your imagination take shape and come to life.

3 Hardware

Consider size & compatibility for cameras/microphone

Take measurements of the room it will be used in to see what size of screen would work best. If you plan to use it frequently for video conferencing, be sure to check if the whiteboard has a camera and microphone built-in or if you can easily connect your existing conferencing camera.

2 App Integration

Seamlessly integrete with your exsisting workflows

Make sure it can seamlessly integrate with your favorite apps, like Slack, Teams, Office, Zoom, Dropbox, Blue Beam, WebEx, etc. so that it fits perfectly within your existing workflows.

Features that Fit

Choose one with features that fit your needs

It's important to choose one with features that fit your own needs. Take a poll from your team on what features are most important to them in a new device. Features could include wireless screencasting, infinite canvas, 3rd party app integration, real-time collaboration, cloud support, etc.

5 Third Device Support

Support PC, mobile and iPad

Check to see if the interactive whiteboard also supports screencasting from computers and mobile devices to the board, regardless of the device's manufacturer.

Annotation

Consider if annotatation would be helpful. Want to make comments, or highlight or circle items? Check if you can do annotation on images, PDFs, Google docs, during screen casting, HDMI, etc.

6 Privacy and Security

Securtity matters

Choose a vendor that takes security and privacy seriously. Check if they offer guest usage and secure login options to maintain security, even in public spaces.
